Don't let the phrase "Quiet Side of the Tetons" fool you! There is so much to see and do here in Teton Valley Idaho! Here are just a few ideas to get you started.

Multi-Use Trail Systems

Surrounded by Caribou-Targhee National Forest areas, Teton Valley provides endless opportunities for outdoor recreation and nature appreciation. In partnership with the Teton Basin Ranger District of the National Forestry Service, Teton Valley Trails and Pathways works hard to maintain the trail systems for your adventurous outdoor enjoyment. Trail systems in the area include multi-use, non-motorized travel great for trail running, hiking, biking and horseback riding, however, please be aware that some trails in the area are reserved for single-use travel.

Water Recreation

Teton River - The Teton River runs through it...the Teton Valley that is! Enjoy world class fishing in a hotspot not often crowded, or take part in a leisurely kayak, packraft or canoe float through the Teton Valley farm fields. Paddle boarding on the river is fast becoming a water recreation favorite for the locals.

The Teton River is easy flowing and family friendly! Wildlife is frequently spotted in the early morning and evening hours. The river is easily accessible at various points throughout the valley; most of which are marked with signs on the highway. If you can't find an access point, just ask a local. They can guide you!

Trail Creek Pond – A family-friendly fishing pond located East of Victor, ID. It is one of the most consistent kid's fisheries in the area.


Spud Drive In


